

Learn from experts how to plan your own walking routes with confidence and with no previous experience needed. Navigating from an OS map can be a bit daunting until you have the skills and know-how to set you on your way.



This one-day navigation course is run in very small groups giving you maximum attention. You will learn to take a 6 figure grid reference for any given position, estimate distance on both map and ground and choose simple navigation strategies.








AFTERNOON TEA IN THE CASTLE Muncaster Castle
